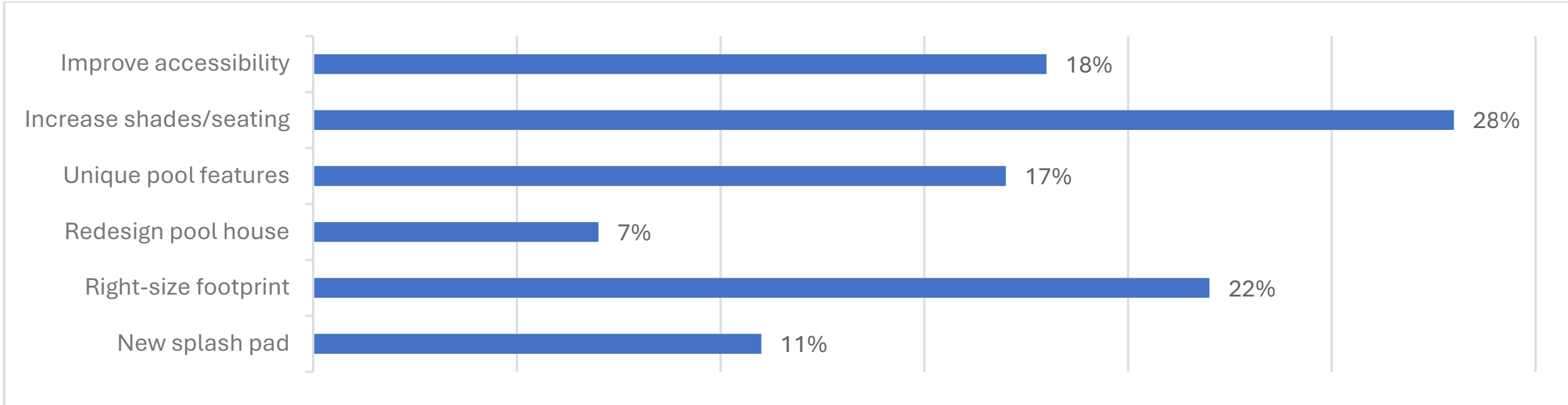
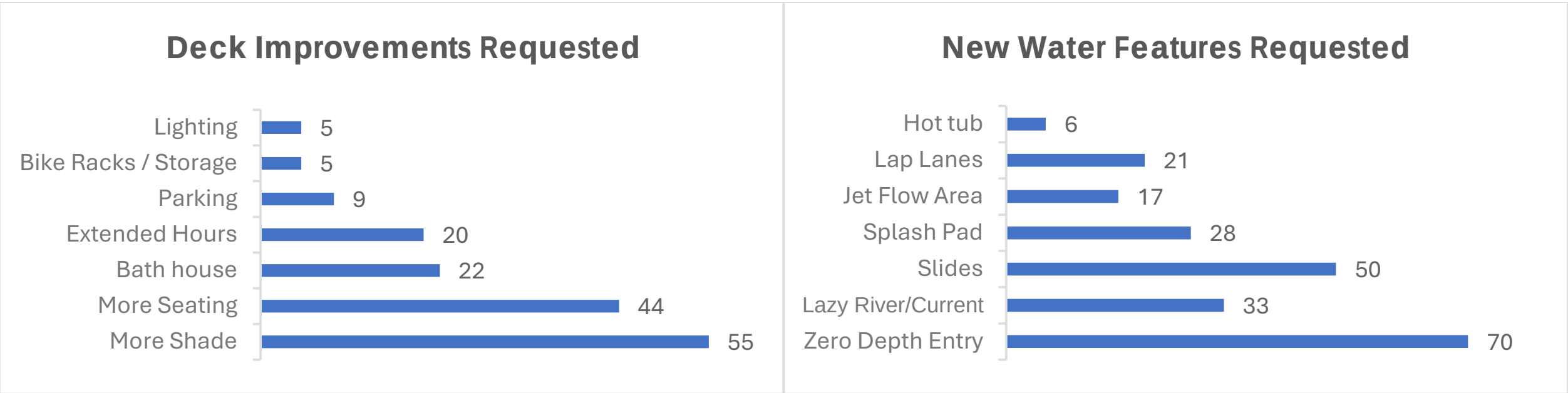


MASTER PLAN PRIORITY RANKING

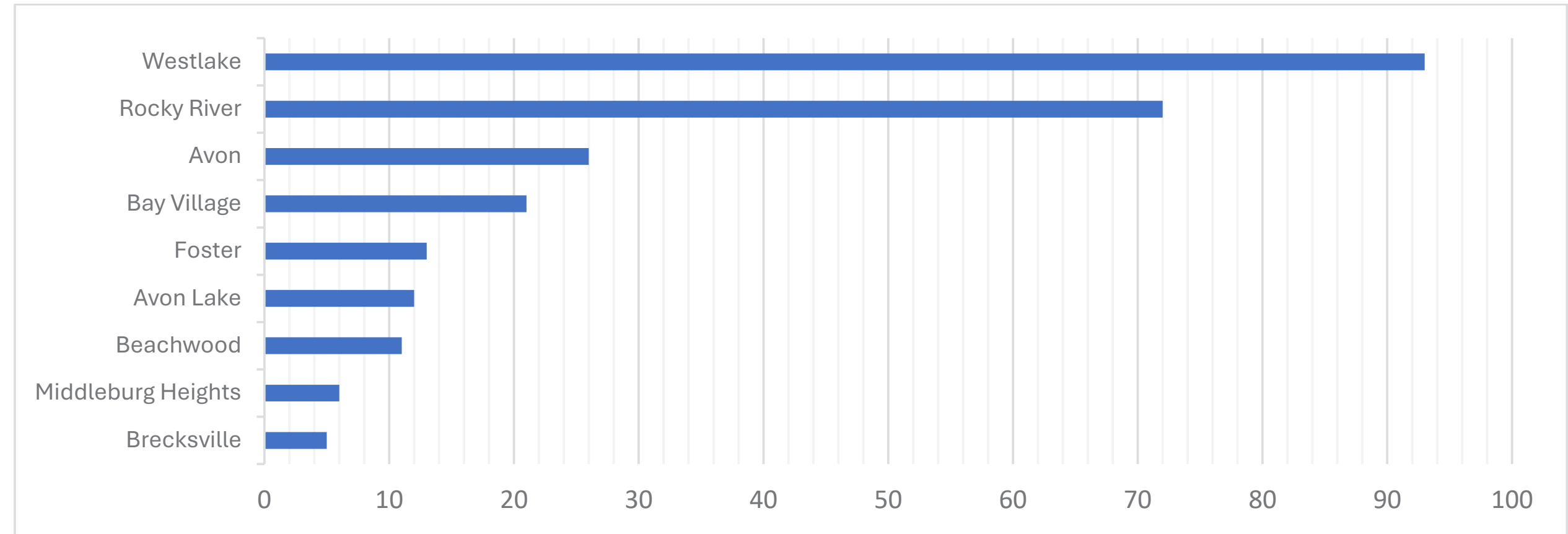
% of respondents ranking each element #1 (most important)

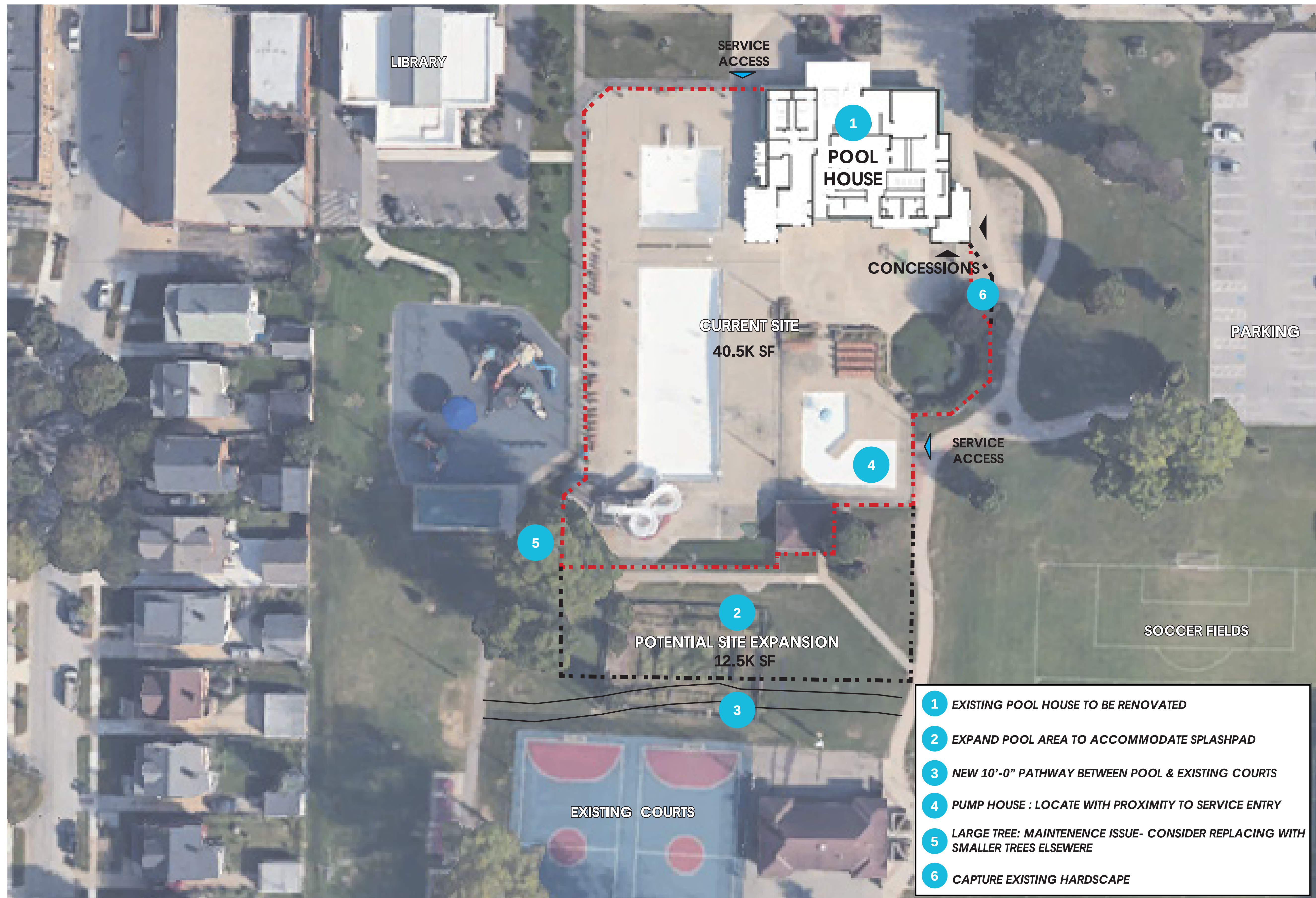


Separate Diving Well

Theme Concept: "Take Flight at Becks Pool"

A Birdtown-Inspired Aquatic Destination for Lakewood, Ohio

The renovation of Becks Pool should celebrate the unique identity of Lakewood's historic Madison Park Birdtown neighborhood while creating a modern, family-focused aquatic destination. The design theme, "Take Flight," draws inspiration from the area's avian street names, migratory patterns along Lake Erie, and the movement of water itself.

Design Vision

The renovated facility becomes a vibrant "urban oasis" where water, nature, recreation, and community converge. Design elements evoke the experience of soaring over Lake Erie wetlands and shoreline habitats, creating an immersive environment that is distinctly Lakewood.

Design Narrative

Guests begin their journey at the entry Bathhouse and move through a series of aquatic environments representing different stages of flight:



Current Channel: "The Migration Route"

Design Elements:

- Curving jet flow walking path inspired by migratory birds
- Native grasses at perimeter
- Small pedestrian connector bridge
- Small "coves" and seating areas



Water features can represent:

- Driftwood structures
- Lake Erie currents
- Wetland channels
- Tributaries flowing into the Great Lakes



Zero-Entry Pool: "The Shoreline"

Design Elements:

- Beach-style entry
- Textured paving resembling shoreline sand patterns
- Family gathering zones and In-water seating
- Child play water structure
- Shade sails
- Educational markers highlighting local nature



Color Palette:

- Lake blue Sand beige Driftwood gray
Sunset Orange Light aqua



Lap Pool: "Open Water"

Design Elements:

- 6 lap swimming lanes
- Clean modern aesthetic
- Dedicated fitness zone
- Spectator seating area
- Baja style Sitting steps



Flexibility:

- This pool can be a separate contained body of water for redundancy.
- Swimming lessons
- Aerobics



Water Slides: "Skyward"

Design Elements:

- Loop slide: Soaring around
- Drop Slide: Plunge diving for fish on the Lake



Potential slide names:

- The Falcon Dive
- Heron's Run
- Hawk Loop
- The Osprey



Splash Pad: "The Wetlands"

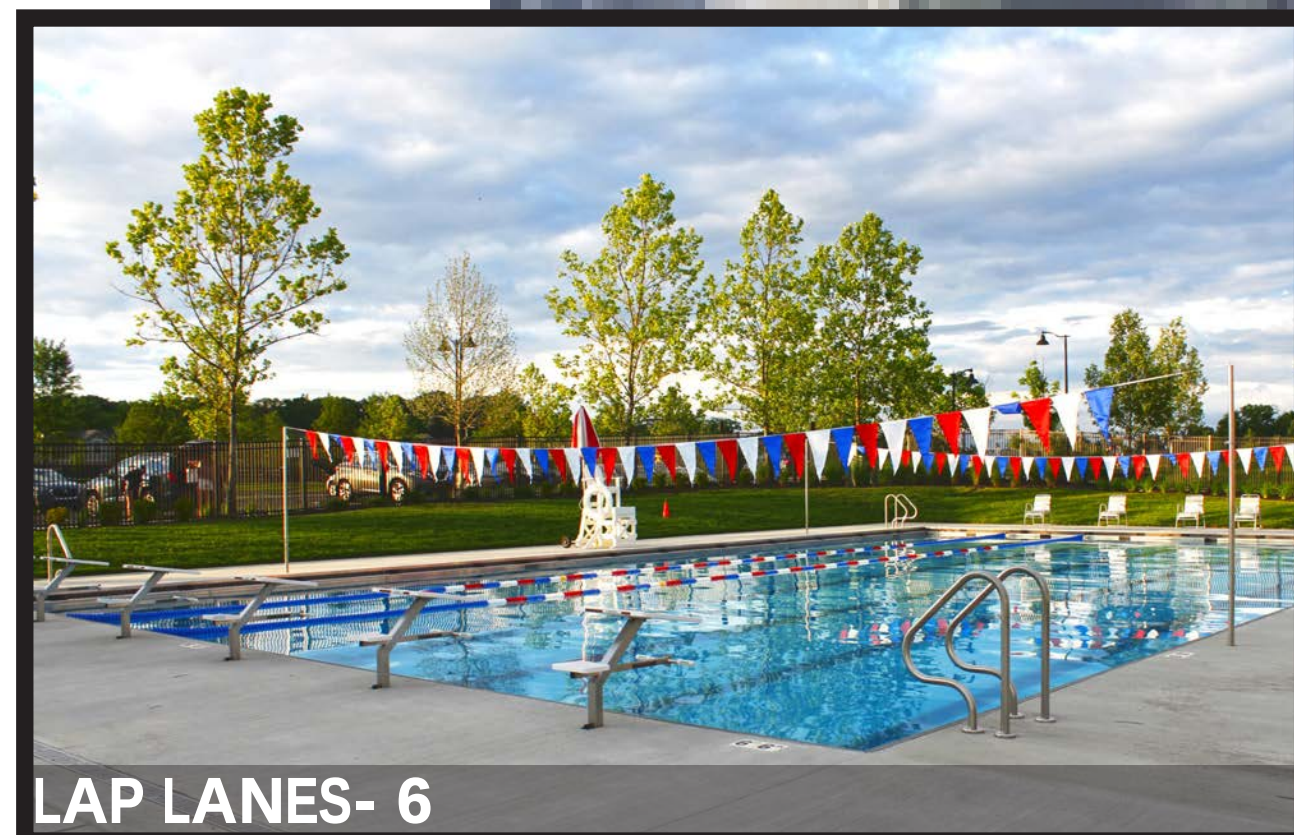
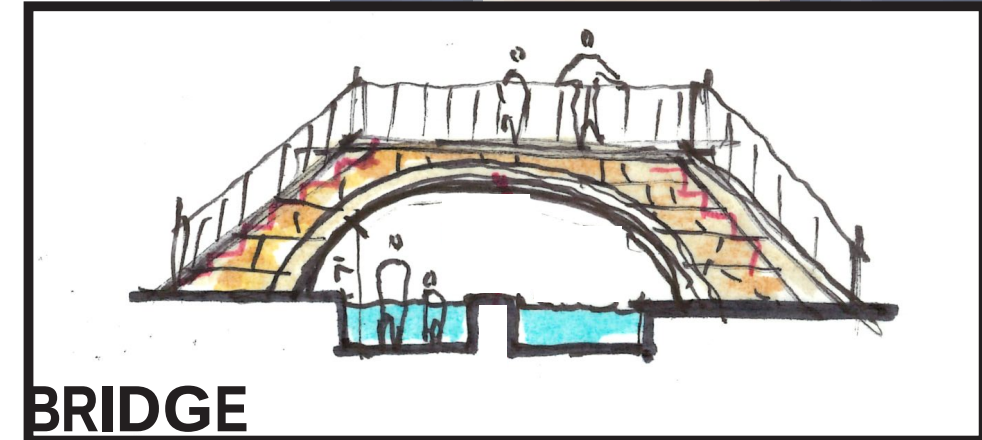
Design Elements:

- 1 ENTRY DOORS- Provide automatic entrance doors
- 2 LIFEGUARD AREA- Replace drop ceiling, counter tops, sinks, and faucets.
- 3 ART MURAL WALL- Preserve existing
- 4 RESTROOMS- New fixtures, faucets, changing stations, and toiletries accessories replacement. Add changing stalls at Men's
- 5 SHOWERS- Replace and improve for ADA accessible for Men's and Women's areas.
- 6 WALLS AND CEILINGS- Paint entire Facility
- 7 FLOORS- Concrete grinded, smoothed, coated, and sealed. Replace Tile.
- 8 ELECTRICAL PANELS- Upgrade as required and relocate out of locker rooms
- 9 LIGHTING- Upgrade to LED and switches to motion activated.
- 10 PLUMBING & DRAINAGE- Replace throughout entire facility. Add plumbing access chase for men's restroom sink
- 11 OUTDOOR SHOWERS- Relocate outdoor showers to wall
- 12 CONCESSION STAND- Provide tenant access. Replaced counter tops, sinks, and faucets. Replace overhead doors. Hot water tank replacement.
- 13 BASEMENT PUMP ROOM- Relocate equipment outside to new pump house
