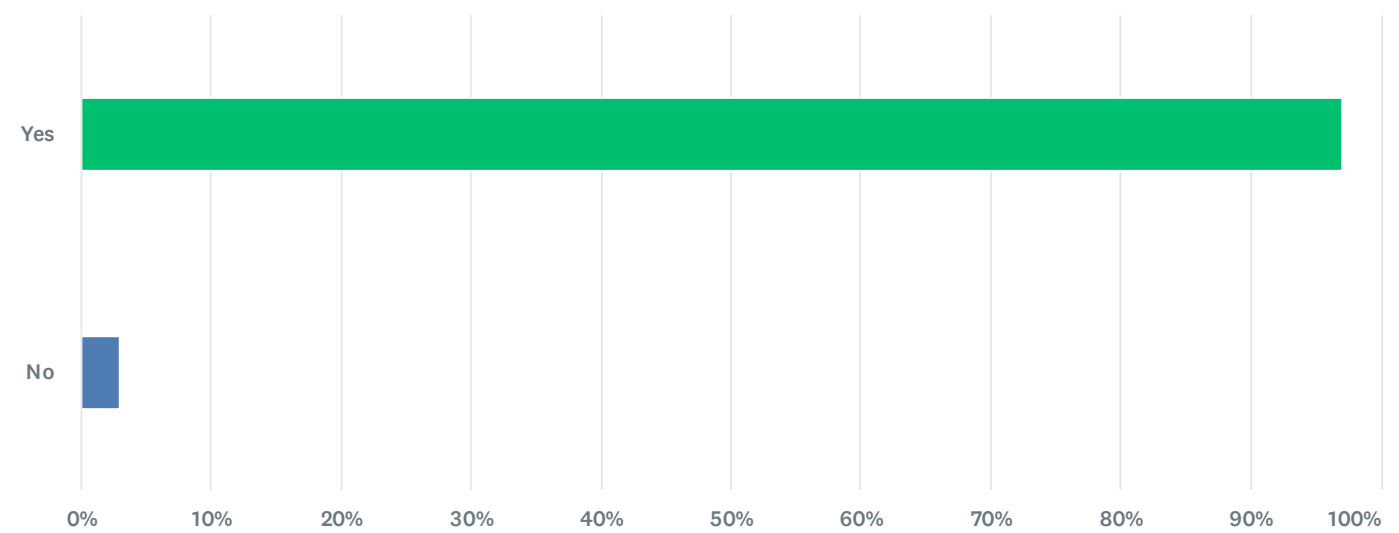


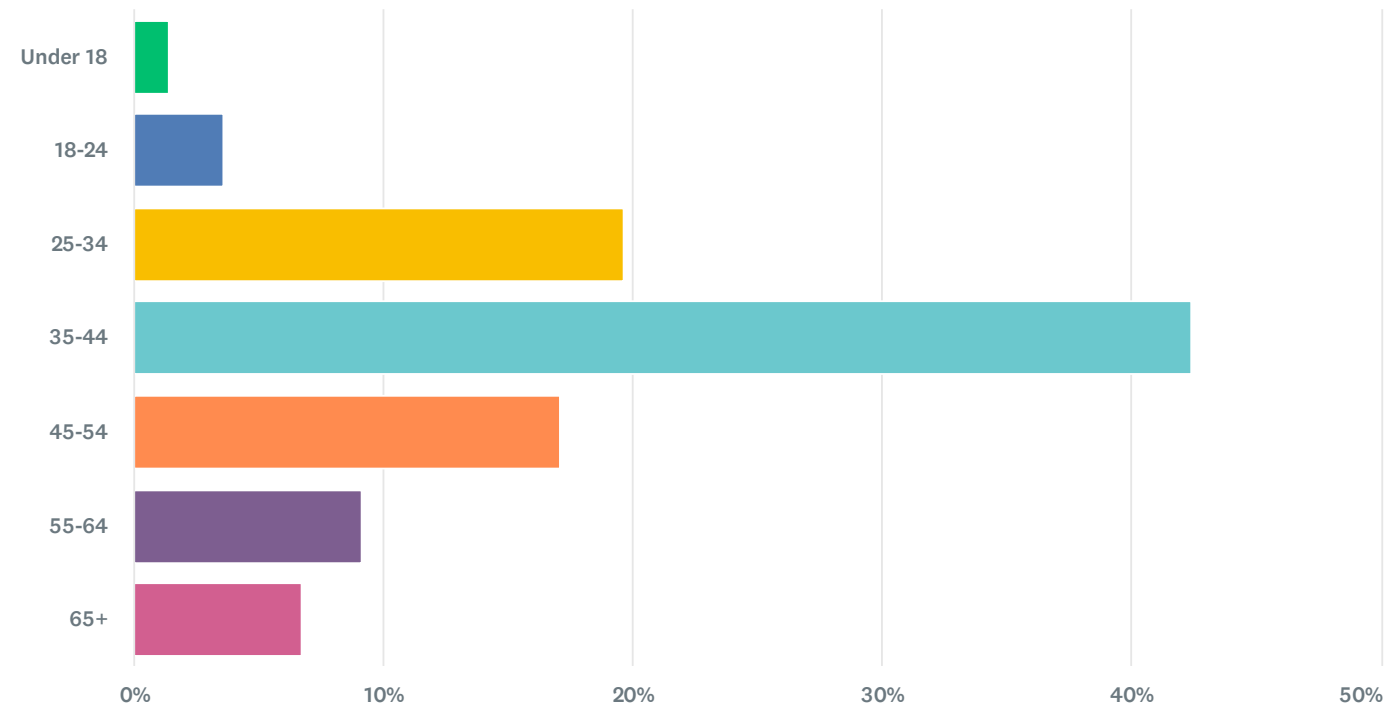

Are you a Lakewood resident?



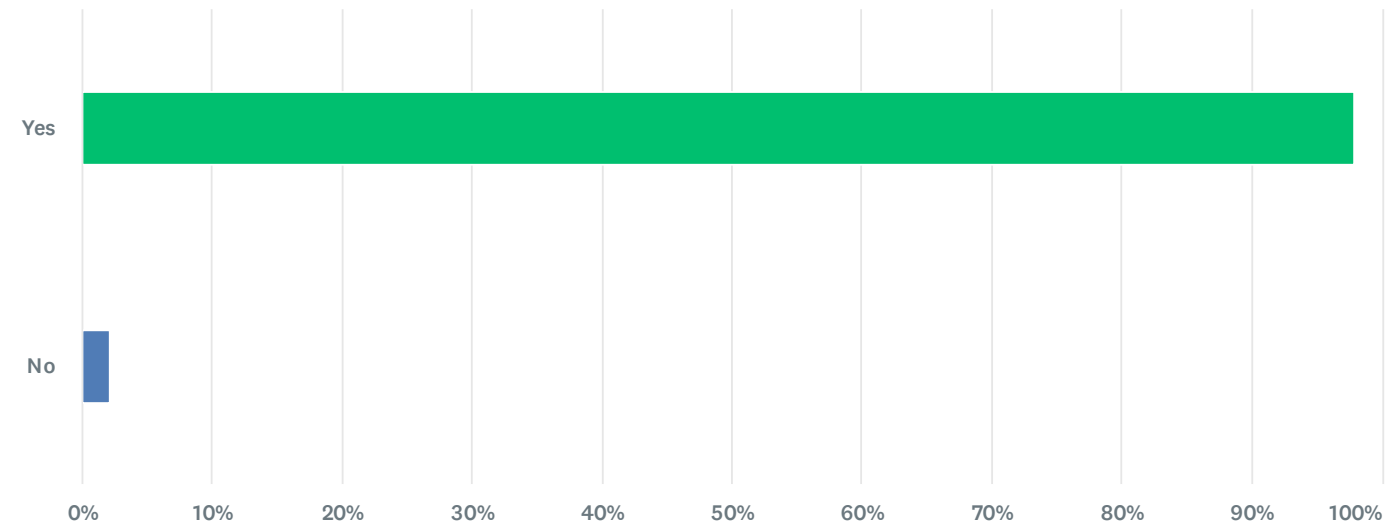

What age group do you fall in?



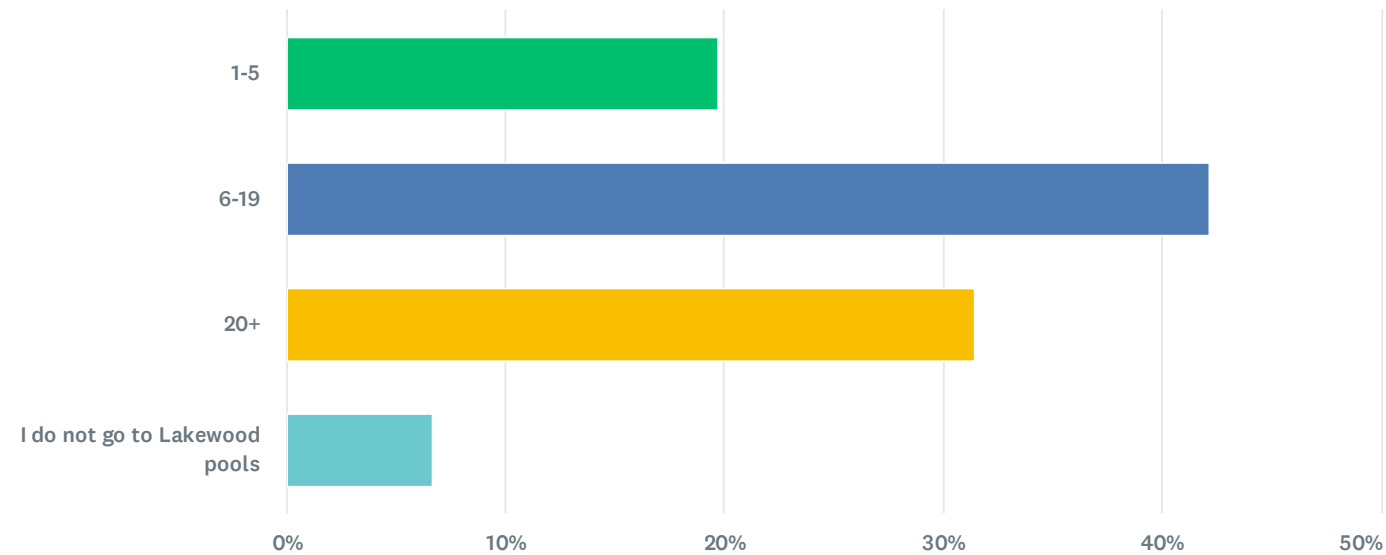
Q3 631 responses

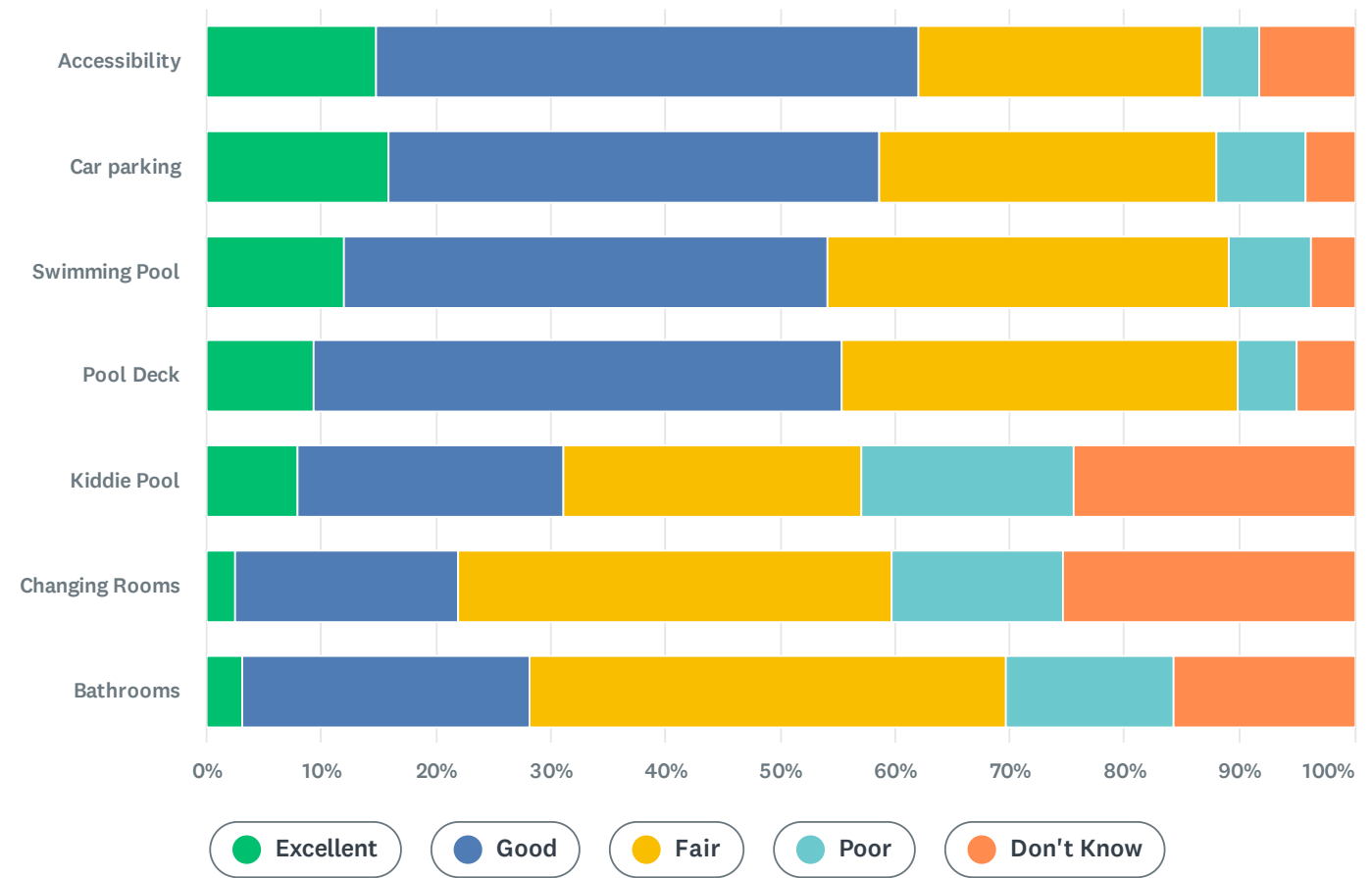

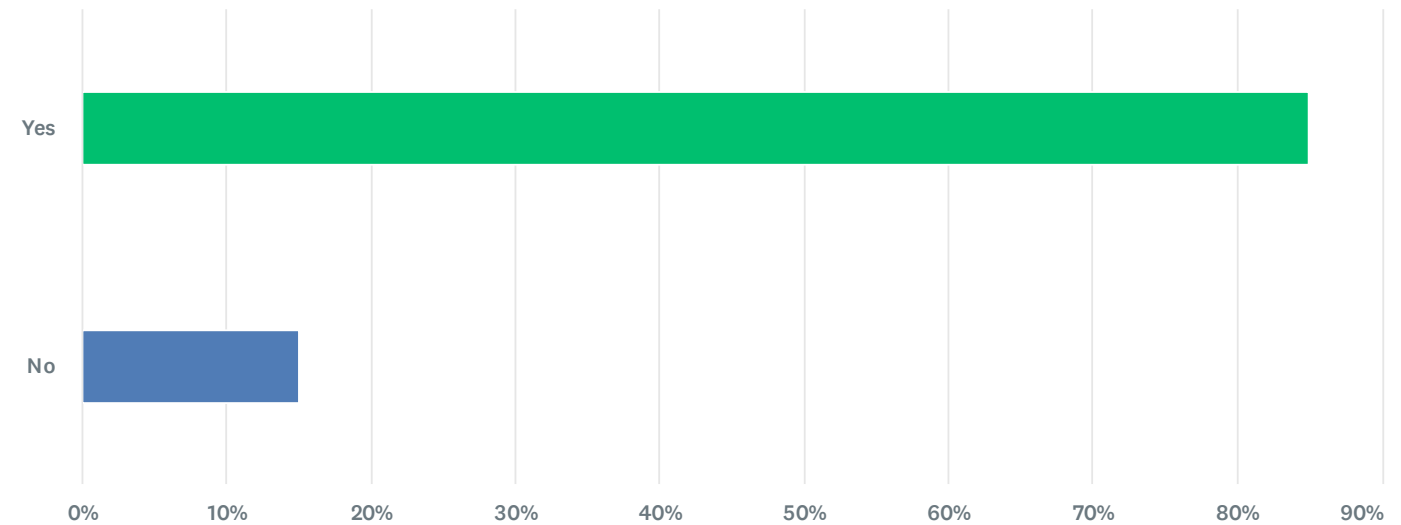

What best describes your level of satisfaction with the current facilities?



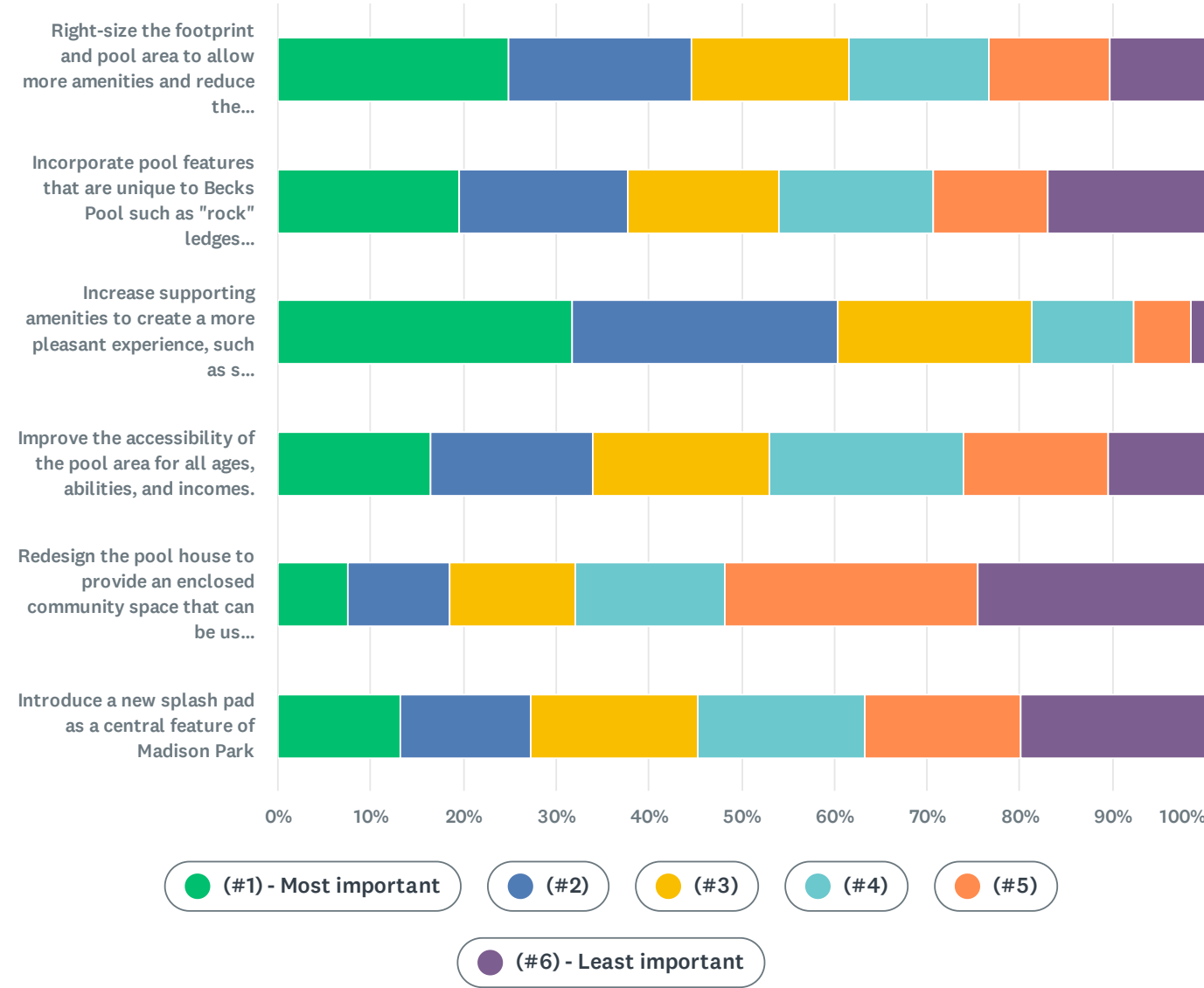

Do you think Becks Pool needs to be updated?



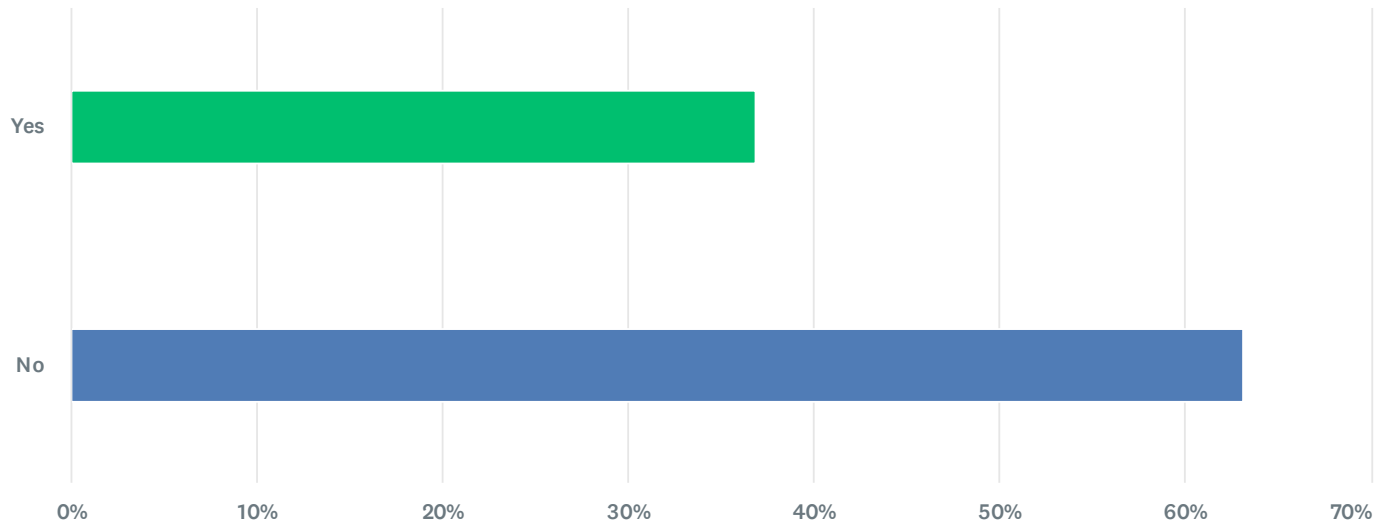

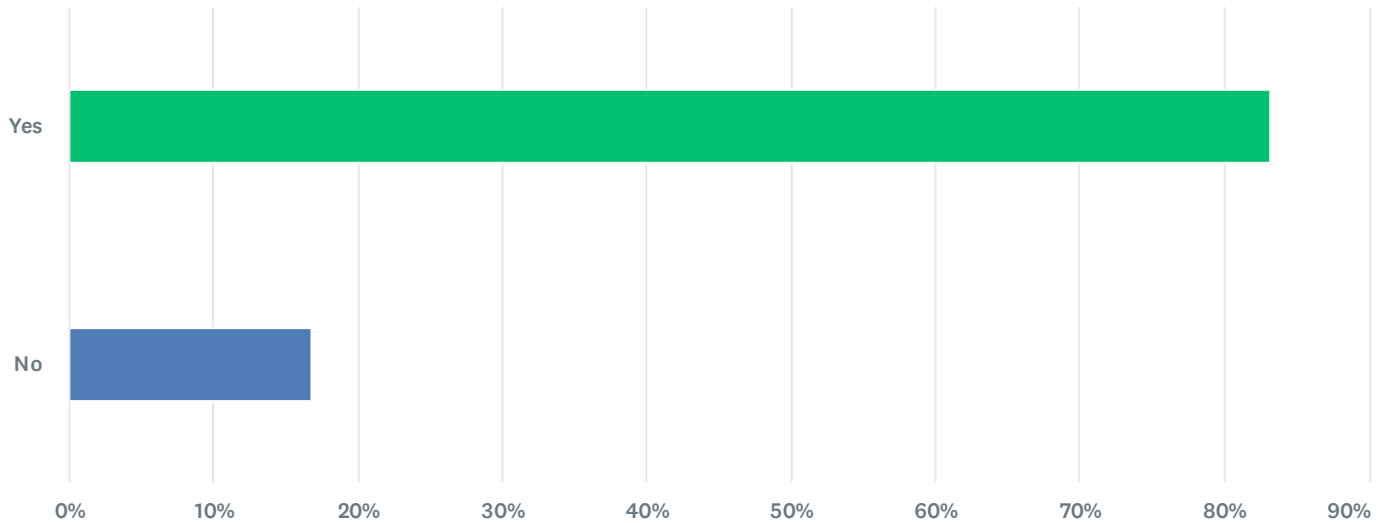
