City of Lakewood, Ohio  
FY26 HUD Annual Action Plan  
Public Review & Comment Period**

As a recipient of federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD), the City of Lakewood prepares a five-year Consolidated Plan implemented via (5) Action Plans that serve as the city's annual funding applications to HUD. Annual Action Plans identify and prioritize the city's housing and non-housing community and economic development needs and describe place-based strategies to provide decent, safe, affordable housing; a suitable living environment; and expanded economic opportunities, primarily for low-moderate income people.

Lakewood's Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC), comprised of (17) residents appointed by Mayor George and City Council, convened (4) times in August and September 2025; reviewed funding applications submitted by City departments and non-profit agencies; and held (2) Public Hearings prior to recommending the following uses for Lakewood's FY26 CDBG (\$1,915,618) and ESG (\$166,057) awards. The \$107,652 in as yet uncommitted FY26 CDBG funds will be allocated according to CAC-approved Contingency Provisions included in Lakewood's draft FY26 Annual Action Plan being issued for public review.
