Who We Serve



- 596 seniors (59.8%) live alone.
- 514 (nearly half) are age 75 or older.
- 685 (68.7%) are women, at highest risk of poverty and isolation.
- 538 live at or below 150% of the federal poverty level.



Staff and Volunteers

- Division of Aging employs 2 Licensed Social Workers.
 - Clinical supervision by the Department's Clinical Manager (LISW-S).
- Community outreach and intake assessments at the Cove and in the field.
 - In-home assessments for homebound seniors.
- Available through the week for crises and emergent needs.





Supportive Service Statistics



- 1,063 seniors aged 62+ active in Division of Aging programs in 2025.
- 905 unduplicated seniors received social work services.
- 2,076 service contacts totaling 1,042.5 hours of direct support.
- 766 annual Participant Intake Forms completed.
